

# CPP31318 – CERTIFICATE III IN SECURITY OPERATIONS CPPSS000059 – Baton & Handcuffs Endorsement

This skill set is suitable for licensed security officers and crowd controllers who are responsible for protecting the safety and security of people, property and premises using baton and handcuffs.

After successful completion of this course you will have the knowledge and skills to apply for employment as a security guard in baton & handcuff security positions.

### **Method of Delivery**

3 day face-to-face training

- Prove your identity documented with a Drivers License, 18+ Proof of Age Card, Keypass Card or Passport (Must provide at least 1 Document)
- 18 years of age or older documented with a Drivers License, 18+ Proof of Age Card, Keypass Card or Passport (Must provide at least 1 Document)
