

CPP31318 – Certificate III in Security Operations CPPSS00063 - Firearms Endorsement

This skill set describes the skills and knowledge required to securely handle, maintain and ensure safety of semi-automatic firearms. This skill set may provide credit towards CPP31318 Certificate III in Security Operations.

On successful completion this may allow you to apply for and/or renew you current Queensland Security Guard (Armed) license with the Queensland Police (Cat H).

Method of Delivery

5 days face-to-face training

This course is delivered from 8:30am until 5:00pm on selected days. The total duration of in-house and live range fire training takes place over 5 days.

Minimum Requirements for Eligibility

To be eligible for this course you are required to meet the following criteria:

- Hold a current Qld Security Guard (unarmed) license
- Be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or Resident documented with a Passport, Citizenship Certificate or Green Medicare Card (Must provide at least 1 Document)
- Prove your identity documented with a Drivers License, 18+ Proof of Age Card, Keypass Card or Passport (Must provide at least 1 Document)
- 18 years of age or older documented with a Drivers License, 18+ Proof of Age Card, Keypass Card or Passport (Must provide at least 1 Document)

We are not CRICOS approved and do not train international students

Units of Competency

Upon successful completion of the course you will be provided with a Statement of Attainment for the following units of competency. To achieve this qualification you will be required to complete and demonstrate an understanding of the following unit of competency through written assessments, verbal assessments and practical display assessments and case scenarios.

CPPSEC3114 – Control security risk situations using firearms

CPPSEC3115 – Carry, operate and maintain revolver for security purposes

CPPSEC3116 - Carry, operate and maintain semi-automatic pistols for security purposes

CPPSEC3117 – Carry, operate and maintain shotgun for security purposes

After successful completion of this course you will have the knowledge and skills to apply for and/or renew your security guard (armed) license (Cat H) with Queensland Police. Alternative Categories may be available upon individual request.
