

HLTPAT005 – Collect Specimens for Drugs of Abuse Testing

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to collect specimens for drugs of abuse testing.

The unit applies to workers who may be required to provide, coordinate and manage a drug and/or alcohol testing site across a range of complex situations, including mining, community and workplace settings.

Method of Delivery

1 day face-to-face training PLUS 18 hours onsite supervision

This course is delivered from 8:30am until 5:00pm on selected days. The total duration of in-house training takes place over one day.

18 hours onsite supervision must be supervised by personnel holding the correct qualification and recorded using the forms provided or a statutory declaration. Advance-Forward may be able to assist with placement however the student can arrange for their own placement.

Minimum Requirements for Eligibility

To be eligible for this course you are required to meet the following criteria:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or Resident documented with a Passport, Citizenship Certificate or Green Medicare Card (Must provide at least 1 Document)
- Prove your identity documented with a Drivers License, 18+ Proof of Age Card, Keypass Card or Passport (Must provide at least 1 Document)
- Students under 18 years of age are required to have parent/guardian permission
